Under this agreement for 2018 Durack State School will receive

\$506,726*

This funding will be used to:

- achieve NAPLAN reading, writing and mathematics relative gain:
 - 80% of students achieve at least one year's academic growth for one year of schooling
 - 2018 to see upward trending, achieved by 2021
- ensure all teaching staff engage with the school assessment schedule to inform classroom practice to improve student outcomes – 2018 review English schedule
- ensure all staff meet the Departmental expectation to plan and align classroom practice with the Australian Curriculum – ongoing
- ensure all SWD, referred students to inclusion committee and students under learning support have personalised learning plans – 2018; all SWD Q3 and Q4 and students under learning support have plans developed and maintained
- ensure classroom practice will reflect the schools pedagogical framework – review and develop framework 2018 aligned practice emerging in practice in all classrooms.

Our initiatives include:

- Data evidenced practices driving improvement (Lyn Sharratt):
 - increase teacher understanding of and response to key data profiles – led by the Principal
- Consistent pedagogical practice across the school (Archer & Hughes):
 - review pedagogical framework, use explicit instruction as an intentional approach to improve student progress – led by Master Teacher/Literacy Coach.
- Consistent curriculum alignment with National Curriculum – National Curriculum, RoleM:
 - improvement agenda focus – English (writing key focus) – led by HOC
 - continue to build mathematical expertise – led by Numeracy Coach.
- Restructure SEP program to ensure equitable access to high quality education led by HOSES.
- Further develop a sense of belonging 2018 - led by Deputy Principal:
 - *Dragons Work for the Common Wealth*
 - Social and self-mastery program – *Play is the Way*.




Our school will improve student outcomes by

- **Specialist and leadership wages** – key additional staff driving the improvement agenda – Literacy Coach, Numeracy Coach and HOC – \$192,000.
- **Targeted support wages** – additional SLP, EAL/D, GO and T-Aide allocation – \$204,726.
- **Capacity Building** – explicit instruction (Archer & Hughes) data analysis, focus groups, STEM projects, RoleM, language, vocabulary and writing development - \$30,000.
- **Literacy** – MINILIT, MACQLIT project, language and vocabulary program and literacy resourcing – \$20,000.
- **Numeracy** – resourcing RoleM and ICT – \$30,000.
- **Inclusion Resources** – early intervention responsive to improve tracking, screening and assessment, plus impact program for upper two bands – \$30,000.
